


Day 01 Arrive Lima

Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel.

Day 02 Lima (B.)

Enjoy a Lima city tour visiting the Main Square (Plaza Mayor), the Government Palace, City Hall, the Cathedral, San Francisco Convent (built in 17th century), and its 'Catacombs' ancient underground cemetery of Lima, and finally the House of El Oidor. Continue to the new residential and commercial areas of San Isidro and Miraflores.

Day 03 Lima / Cuzco (B.)

A morning flight to Cuzco and the afternoon will be spent on touring this magnificent city and the nearby ruins – a blend of Inca and Spanish cultures. Visit to the Korikancha or, Temple of the Sun and the Cathedral, continuing to the nearby ruins of Tambomachay (Inca

fountains), Puca-Pucara (the Red Fortress), Kenko (sacred site) and finally Sacsahuaman Fortress.

Day 04

Cuzco/Sacred Valley/Cuzco (B. L.)

A morning visit to Pisac, famous for its Mass and market. After lunch break, tour the remarkable Inca fortress of Ollantaytambo with its magnificent mountain stairway.

Day 05

Cuzco/Machu Picchu/Cuzco (B. L.)

After breakfast, a transfer to the railway station and enjoy a train journey through Urumbamba Valley, the Sacred Valley of the Incas, to the fabulous mountaintop ruins of Machu Picchu. Located high above the clouds, the city's streets, temples and staircases spread across a jungle ridge that eventually plunges more than 300 metres into the



treacherous waters of the Rio Urubamba below. Return to Cuzco by train after the visit.

Day 06 Cuzco / Puno (B.)

Depart for Puno traveling along the Andes range, passing through picturesque villages up to the town of Juliaca. Visit to Andahuaylillas, Racchi ruins, Pucara and La Raya. On arrival in Puno, check into your hotel, which is on the shores of Lake Titicaca.

Day 07 Puno (B. L.)

Enjoy a morning visit to the Uros Islands. These islands are made of reeds, rising six metres above the lake level. They are anchored by logs and connected to each other by ropes. The main activity of the local people is fishing and handcrafting several items that they sell to visitors. Continue to Taguile Island which has two essential characteristics. Its geography offers a spectacular view from the hills and its standing as a first-rate textile centre.

Day 08 Puno / Lima / Buenos Aires (B.)

Transfer to airport and a flight to Lima and you will be assisted at Lima Airport for a connecting flight to Buenos Aires. On arrival, transfer to your hotel. Buenos Aires is a complex, energetic and seductive port city, which stretches south-to-north along the Rio de la Plata. It has been the gateway to Argentina for centuries.

Day 09 Buenos Aires (B. DS.)

A city tour introduces a visit to Avenue 9 de Julio, Colon Theatre and the Obelisk 'the symbol of Buenos Aires'. Continue to Plaza de Mayo and the south of the city passing through San Telmo with its 'tanguerías', la Boca and Caminito. Onto Puerto Madero, the renewed port of the city and important gastronomic area. Also, a visit to the biggest green space, Palermo, with its parks and buildings and last Recoleta, a neighbourhood where culture and elegance live together. This evening, enjoy a Tango show and dinner at the magnificent Tango Porteno.

Day 10 Buenos Aires (B.)

Excursion to the northern districts, Tigre and Delta. Lies 30 km away from the city, Tigre and its delta leads up deep into a natural scenery where the thickness of the

shrub land is embraced by various channels of reddish waters. The delta is the third largest in the world, following the famous Nile River Delta and the Amazons River. Nevertheless, its 27 thousand sq. km have been hardly exploited. Enjoy one hour boat ride on the Delta.

Day 11 Buenos Aires / Iguassu (B.)

Transfer to airport and a flight to Iguassu – famous for Iguassu Falls (the widest and most imposing water falls on earth). You will experience the Argentinean side of the fall today including the Upper, Lower and the Devil's Throat Circuits.

Day 12 Iguassu / Rio De Janeiro (B.)

This morning, experience the Brazilian side of the Falls. The walkway entering Iguazu River next to the Floriano Fall gives a refreshing reception and a gorgeous view of the lower part of the river and the Devil's Canyon. Later, transfer to the airport and a flight to Rio de Janeiro. 'The Marvelous City' is world renowned for its breathtaking landscapes and location.

Day 13 Rio de Janeiro (B.)

Depart for a Sugar Loaf excursion. It begins with a city panoramic view through downtown Rio, passing by the Maracana Stadium, the Sambodrome, and Metropolitan Cathedral. Get to know the traditional Cinelandia Square with historical buildings, the Municipal Theatre, the National Library and the National Museum of Fine Arts. By taking the Aterro do Flamingo, you will be taken to the neighbourhood of Urca where one of the largest symbols of the city is located: the Sugar Loaf. In the afternoon, take a train ride to the Corcovado Mountain with the gigantic statue of Christ the Redeemer (2,300 feet above sea level).

Day 14 Rio de Janeiro (B.)

Spend a day free for your own exploration. Tonight, enjoy the glamour and rhythm of a colourful samba show. You will be entertained by brilliantly costumed dancers and musicians, with the option to enjoy a delicious buffet dinner at a Brazilian steakhouse.

Day 15 Depart Rio (B.)

A transfer to the airport for your onward flight.
