

Easy Nepal (8 days / 7 nights)

**** Based on 4-star hotels (Land only)

Day 01	Arrive Kathmandu / Nagarkot (D.): On arrival, a transfer to Nagarkot (32 km), one of the most scenic spots and renowned for its spectacular view of the Himalaya.
Day 02	Nagarkot / Kathmandu (B. L.): After enjoying the sunrise over the Himalayas, drive back to Kathmandu. Visits to Bhaktapur Durbar Square including the Lion Gate, Golden Gate, 55 Windows Palace, Nyatapola Temple, etc. Onto Pashupatinath Temple, with its astonishing architectural beauty and regarded as the most sacred temple of Hindu Lord Shiva. Finish the day with a visit to Boudhanath Stupa, one of the oldest and biggest in Nepal.
Day 03	Kathmandu (B. L.): Sightseeing introduces Kathmandu Durbar Square, a cluster of ancient temples, palaces, courtyards and streets that date back to 12th to 18th century. It is also the site for important ceremonies such as the coronation of the Nepalese monarch. The Swoyambhunath Stupa, one of the most popular, holy and recognizable symbols of Nepal, as well as a monument listed by UNESCO. The Patan Durbar Square, houses the residence of the former Patan Royal family.
Day 04	Kathmandu / Pokhara (B. L.): Enjoy a 6-hour scenic drive through mountains and villages to Pokhara, surrounded by three out of the ten highest mountains in the world (Dhaulagiri, Annapurna and Manaslu).
Day 05	Pokhara (B. L.): Enjoy a morning excursion to Sarankot to view the sunrise over the Himalaya. Tour of Davis Fall, Gupteshwor Mahadey Cave, Tibetan Refugee Camp and Bendabasini Temple. Finish the day with a one hour boat cruise in Phewa Lake.
Day 06	Return to Kathmandu (B. L.): Drive back to Kathmandu and check into the hotel.
Day 07	Kathmandu (B. L.): A tour to Bundamati and Khokana Village and Thamel Street...
Day 08	Departure (B.): Free at your own leisure till a transfer to airport for your international flight.
